### CHRISTMAS COOKIES



#### Try this simple recipe!

#### Ingredients:

- 250 g self raising flour (plus extra for rolling out)
- 125 g cold butter cut into 1cm cubes (plus extra for greasing)
- (Optional) ½ teaspoon cinnamon
- (Optional) ½ teaspoon ginger
- 125 g caster sugar
- 1 egg beaten
- 1. Preheat your oven to 200C/180C Fan/ Gas 6.
- 2. Put the flour and butter in a bowl. Rub it between your fingers until it looks like breadcrumbs.
- 3. Add the sugar and spices and mix.
- 4. Add the beaten egg and mix.
- 5. Squish it into a ball.
- 6. Roll the ball flat on the counter.
- 7. Cut out shapes.
- 8. Cook for 10-15 minutes.
- 9. Let them cool, then decorate!
